Encana Courtesy Notice

Encana to finish pipeline right of way work along County Road 5 Starting November 30, 2015

Encana has reached an agreement with Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) regarding the section of pipeline right of way where buried trash was disturbed during pipeline trenching in 2014. As part of this agreement, Encana will complete its pipeline work and execute a CDPHE-approved closure plan to remove and dispose of the buried trash that was previously encountered.

Beginning November 30, 2015, Encana will be near the intersection of County Road 5 and County Road 6, removing the trash and installing the pipeline associated with the Hub Central Gathering Facility. During this activity, the trench will be reopened and the disturbed trash will be removed using excavators and placed directly into dump trucks for transportation to CDDPHE-approved facilities. Certified inspectors will be onsite to characterize each load that is being transferred. The waste will be characterized, handled and disposed of appropriately and in compliance with the approved CDPHE plan.

Encana anticipates this activity will last approximately three weeks. All work will be conducted during daylight hours and may include some weekend work. A traffic management plan will be in place and street sweepers will be on hand to mitigate any mud tracking.
