Erie Board of Trustees Action Items – June 28, 2011

Board Approves Safe Routes to School Project Construction – The Board awarded a construction contract in the amount of \$125,000 for construction of a Safe Routes to School project. The project includes construction of an 8-foot concrete sidewalk along County Line Road from Erie Elementary south to Telleen Avenue. The project is scheduled to begin this summer with completion anticipated by this fall.

Board Approves Fair Contributions to School Agreement with BVSD – The Board approved a resolution authorizing the Town to enter into an agreement for fair contributions with the Boulder Valley School District (BVSD). The purpose of this agreement is to provide adequate public school sites to serve the Town residents of newly constructed residential dwellings. The Town of Erie previously entered into an Agreement for Fair Contributions for Public School Sites in 2001. The current agreement expires in September of this year. The fee, paid by developers, for single-family cash-in-lieu contributions for BVSD is \$970 per unit. This fee is the same as that paid to the St. Vrain Valley School District.

BACKGROUND: Growth in residential land development and the construction of new residential dwellings in the Town necessitates the acquisition of additional public school sites to accommodate the corresponding increases in the student population. Requiring land dedication for conveyance for public school sites or payments in lieu of land dedication or conveyance for public school sites will provide a portion of the land to meet such demand.
