

Erie Drive-In Rules



Thank you all for your interest and participation in our first Drive-In Movie Series. As always, the safety and wellbeing of our community is a top priority for the Erie Parks & Recreation Department. We're committed in following all health guidelines and requirements to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Please help us in our efforts by abiding by the following rules:

1. Participants **MUST** stay in their vehicle at all times. This includes the following:
 - No playing outside prior to the movie showing
 - No setting up lawn chairs or blankets outside of your vehicle
 - No sitting in the bed of a pickup truck
 - All hatches must remained closed

The only exception to this rule is for the use of restroom facilities.

2. **RESTROOMS:** Our facilities are located north of our drive-in area at Erie Community Park. There will be a masked staff member onsite to monitor lines and clean after every use. Social distancing markers will be placed to ensure safety.
3. **PARKING:** Our event staff will assist you in parking your vehicle to ensure proper placement. Some notes on parking include:
 - Only park with vehicles facing the screen
 - Staff will be parking vehicles roughly 10 ft. apart to ensure a safe distance among vehicles
 - Large/tall vehicles (SUVs, Trucks, Vans, etc.) will be parked towards the rear of the venue to allow the view of smaller vehicles in attendance.
4. **TRASH:** To minimize any potential exposure to staff, please plan to leave your trash in your vehicle and take home with you!
5. **FM RADIO:** This event will be using FM radio for sound. You will have to use your car stereo/radio or bring a portable FM Radio with you. We'll have the station to tune into available for that evening.
6. **COMMON COURTESY:** To allow for a good experience for all, follow these guidelines:
 - Turn off all lights
 - Avoid running your car for the entire movie
 - Stay for the entire movie

We hope you enjoy this unique experience with us! At the end of the movie, turn on your lights and exit safely.
