

**Town of Erie
Resolution No. 22-104**

A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie Submitting the Ballot Question to Form a Home Rule Charter Commission to the Town's Registered Electors at the November 8, 2022 Special Election, and Listing Candidates for the Charter Commission

Whereas, by adoption of Ordinance No. 15-2022, the Board of Trustees called a special election to be coordinated with Boulder and Weld Counties as part of the November 8, 2022, general election for the purpose of forming a Home Rule Charter Commission and electing members thereof;

Whereas, the Town received 18 valid nomination petitions; and

Whereas, on August 22, 2022, the Town Clerk conducted a lot drawing to set the order in which the candidates' names would appear on the ballot.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. As stated in Ordinance No. 15-2022, the following question shall be submitted to a vote of the registered electors of the Town in accordance with Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the Municipal Home Rule Act of 1971, at the special election to be coordinated with the general election to be held on November 8, 2022:

Shall the Town of Erie form a Home Rule Charter Commission
for the purpose of drafting a home rule charter?




