



Tree Treatment

Is a Tree Work Permit required to treat a tree?

- A Tree Work Permit is required to treat any tree or woody plant originating within the public right of way (area located between the curb and the sidewalk) of any street, sidewalk, or alley, or upon other town-owned property within the town.
 - Permits are required for all treatment methods including foliar, trunk, and root applications that target insects and diseases.
- Tree Work Permits are **not** required to perform any work on trees located wholly on private properties.

Any contractor that engages in the business of applying pesticides within the town shall carry a current Pesticide Applicators License issued by the State of Colorado, in addition to possessing Arborist License, regardless of whether the treatments are applied on Town-owned or private property.
