We are writing today to let you know about routine maintenance activity you will see on an existing oil and natural gas well near your community in the near future. Please see the map on the reverse side for reference.

The work is scheduled to **begin on or around March 24nd** and will take approximately three to seven days. A work truck and temporary tank will be needed to conduct this operation. In an effort to reduce the inconvenience to the surrounding residents, crews will be working on site Monday through Friday during daylight hours only. During operations, you may notice a slight increase in traffic and are likely to hear the activity.
