

Hello,

We are writing to let you know about upcoming activity on an existing oil and natural gas well in your area. Please see the map on the reverse side for reference.

The subject well is scheduled to be retired from oil and natural gas development. This procedure is commonly referred to as Plug and Abandonment and is regulated by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. During this operation the well will be plugged, the associated surface equipment removed, and the land reclaimed to match the existing landscape. A work-over rig (pictured on the reverse side) and other heavy equipment will be needed to conduct this operation.

The work is scheduled to **begin on or around April 13th** and will take approximately one to two weeks. In an effort to reduce the inconvenience to the surrounding residents, crews will be working on site Monday through Friday during daylight hours only.

You may notice a slight increase in traffic and are likely to hear the activity during operations. On the first day of operations, the crews will safely relieve the pressure from the well during which you are likely to hear a loud rumble. This is a standard, one time procedure and it will last anywhere from 30 minutes to one hour.
