POLICY:

CACP STANDARD 10.1

The position of police officer is a public trust to uphold and enforce society’s laws faithfully and impartially. Therefore, every person entering the police service as a member of the Erie Police Department shall take the prescribed Oath of Office.

PROCEDURES:

I. OATH OF OFFICE

The Oath of Office shall be administered by the Erie Town Clerk or Deputy Town Clerk typically within seven (7) days of the new officer’s first day of work.

II. SIGNED OATH OF OFFICE

The signed Oath of Office shall be retained as a permanent record in the member’s personnel file.

III. OATH OF OFFICE - VERBAGE

The Oath of Office shall read as follows:

I, _____, do solemnly swear I will support the Constitution of the United States, the State of Colorado, and the Ordinances of the Town of Erie, Colorado, and faithfully perform the duties of Police Officer upon which I am about to enter.
