On-duty supervisor notifies SDO of Collision

SDO responds if necessary and determines investigating agency based on location and severity of the collision. If there are injuries to any party, Colorado State Patrol will generally be requested to investigate the collision.

Did the Officer's actions contribute to the collision **and** did a vehicle need to be towed, or is there injury involved in the collision?

Fill out Supervisors Accident report and complete necessary workman's comp paperwork.
