We are writing today to let you know about maintenance activity you will see on an existing oil and natural gas well near your community in the coming weeks. Please see the map on the reverse side for reference.

The work is scheduled to **begin on or around June 6th** and will take approximately three to five days. A work-over rig (pictured on the reverse side) and other heavy equipment will be needed to conduct this operation. In an effort to reduce the inconvenience to the surrounding residents, crews will be working on site Monday through Friday during daylight hours only. You may notice a slight increase in traffic and are likely to hear the activity during operations. We will be pressure testing during this activity.

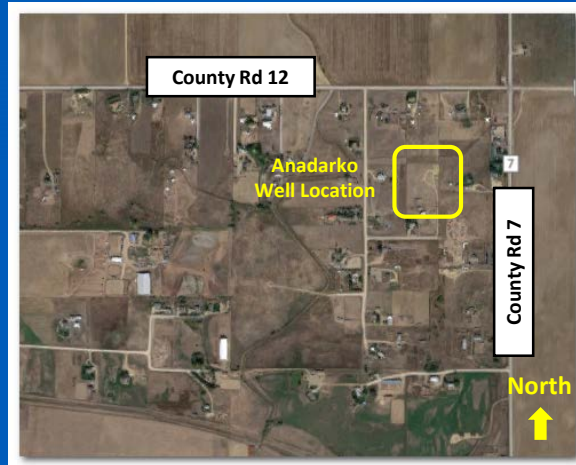
